- do not have visitors in your home, including friends and family except for essential care
- try to avoid contact with anyone you live with as much as possible

Please note that when learning on-line children will be required to use appropriate grammar and language instead of texting language when communicating with their teacher and the site will only be used to discuss school-related content.

Please note that reading at home is expected on a daily basis. Google Classroom is a free, secure and safe learning network for teachers, children and schools. Using Google Classroom allows you and your child to have access to home learning at any time through the Internet and is accessible through any mobile devices with Internet capabilities—including iPhone, iPad and Android devices. Google Classroom is used as an educational tool and will be used strictly for educational purposes.

Other important notices.

- For the foreseeable future we will continue to line children up outside at home time. As autumn approaches we cannot stress enough how important it is that you send your children in with raincoats or coats. This will also enable outdoor learning to take place whenever possible.
- Please send your child in with their own water bottle to assist us in avoiding the use of plastic cups during Covid.
