## Message From Borehamwood Library Service

Dear Parent and carers

Borehamwood Library is open for Ready Reads – “we select , you collect”

- you pre-order packs of books – adult and child packs available,
- library staff choose the books and issue them to your card,
- we email to let you know your book packs are ready
- you collect from the library door

It's that easy!

All you need to do is fill out the online form with details of the type of books required.

If you don't yet have a library card you can join you and your child to the library where you will receive a temporary membership number which can be used to access the online eBook and Audiobook library Borrow Box.

Social distancing measure will be in place, facemasks will need to be worn on site and all books have been quarantined before issuing them to you. If you are unable to access online services, please phone 0300 123 4049 and a member of the library service team will be able to help you fill out the form.
